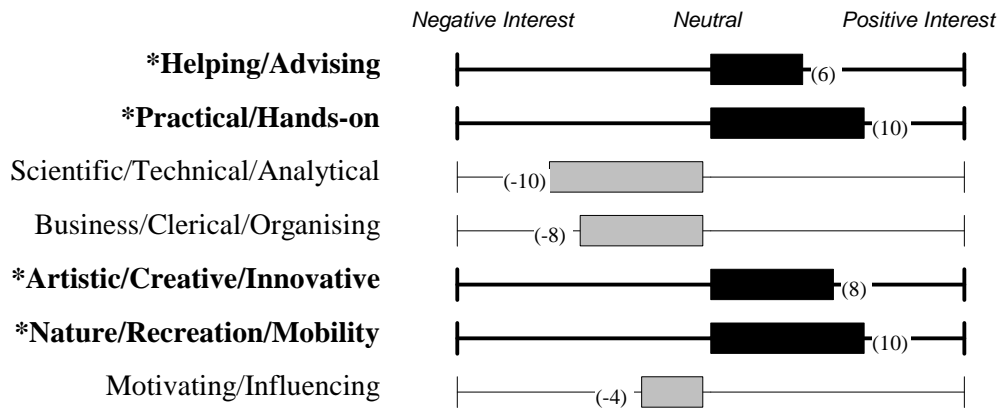

Specialisations: Animal Attendant, Animal Carer, Animal Groomer, Animal Rehabilitation Worker, Animal Rescue Worker, Animal Washer/Dog Washer, Animal/Dog/Horse Clipper, Breeder, Customs Dog Trainer, Dog Catcher, Dog Handler, Dog Trainer, Dog Walker, Guide Dog Instructor, Guide Dog Trainer, Horse Exerciser, Kennel Attendant/Hand, Nature Fauna Rehabilitation Worker, Pet Shop Attendant, Police/Armed Forces/Security Dog Trainer, Rescue Dog Trainer, RSPCA Officer, Zoo Attendant, Zoo Keeper.

1 Clothing Tradesperson/Costume Maker

Makes, alters and repairs women's or men's tailored garments, formal wear, couturier clothing, or special occasion wear, such as suits, dresses, coats, evening wear and bridal wear.

Specialisations: Theatrical Dresser, Wardrobe Assistant, Wardrobe Co-ordinator.

Related Titles: Dressmaker, Tailor.

1 Confectioner/Chocolate Maker

Prepares ingredients, makes, shapes and wraps or box toffees, chocolates and other sweets.

Specialisations: Chocolate Maker.

1 Park Ranger/Fisheries Inspector

Controls state or national parks, scenic areas, historic sites, nature reserves, recreation areas or conservation reserves in accordance with government policies and priorities.

Specialisations: Fisheries Inspector.

Related Titles: Landcare Officer, National Park Ranger.

1 Sewing/Knitting Craftsperson

Creates clothing, toys and other decorative articles from hand or machine knitting or sewing.

2 Caterer

Discusses with clients their entertainment needs, draws up suitable menus and function arrangements, arranges and supervises the preparation and serving of food and drinks at private functions, and may organise seating and music.

2 Hat Maker/Furrier

Makes, alters and repairs hats (a hat maker is known as a Milliner) or makes, alters and repairs fur clothing.

Specialisations: Fur Cutter, Fur Matcher, Furrier (makes fur clothing), Milliner (hat maker).

2 Nanny/Babysitter

Assists parents to look after and care for babies and children, usually in the child's home.

Specialisations: Baby Sitter, Child Minder, Children's Nursery Assistant, Creche Attendant, Day Care Worker, Governess.

Related Titles: Au pair, Babysitter, Child Care Worker, Child Minder, Children's Care Worker.

2 Picture Framer

Cuts out and assembles wooden, metal or other mouldings to make picture frames, cuts glass and cardboard overlays to size, and assembles and frames paintings, photographs, needlework and other artwork.

Related Titles: Picture Frame Maker.

2 Window Dresser/Visual Merchandiser

Plans and installs window and other displays of goods to attract customer attention, to show off goods to their best advantage, and to encourage the sale of goods.

Related Titles: Visual Merchandiser, Window Decorator, Window Dresser.
