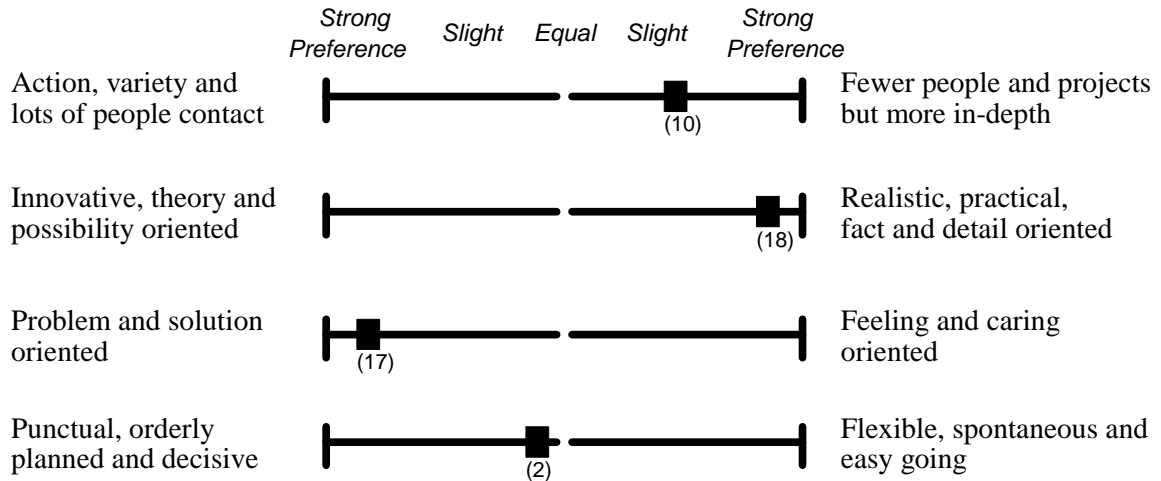

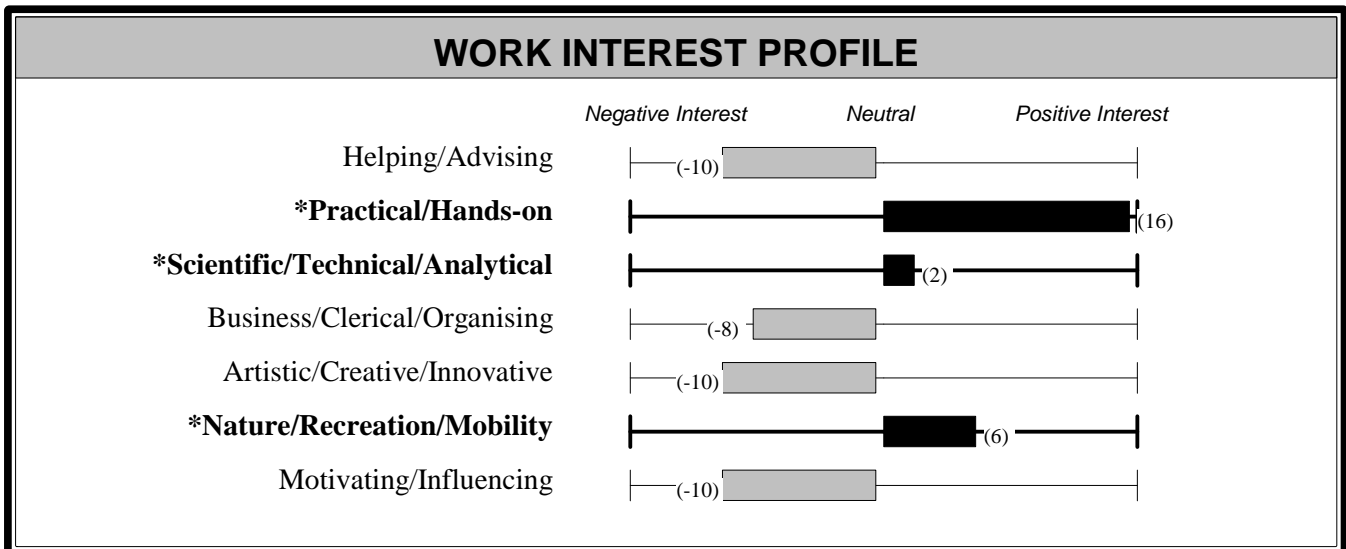

1 Defence (Army/Navy/Air Force) Tech./Trade

Members of the defence force (army, navy, airforce) who use engineering or other technical skills to design, build, operate or maintain technical military equipment.

Specialisations: Airborne Electronics Analyst, Ammunition Technician, Armament Fitter, Armament Mechanic, Explosive Ordnance Demolition Technician, Military Armament Engineer, Military Explosives Technician, Military Instrument Engineer, Recovery Mechanic, Weapons Specialist.

1 Locksmith

Installs and maintains locks and related security devices and systems.

Specialisations: Safemaker.

1 Motor Mechanic

Repairs, maintains and tests vehicle or other engines and related mechanical parts.

Specialisations: Automatic Transmission Mechanic, Automotive Airconditioning Mechanic, Bicycle Repairer, Brake Mechanic, Chainsaw Mechanic, Diesel Motor Mechanic, Heavy Vehicle Mechanic, Lawnmower Mechanic, Marine Mechanic, Motorcycle Mechanic, Outboard Motor Mechanic.

Related Titles: Mechanic.

1 Precision Instrument Maker/Repairer

Assembles, tests, installs and overhauls mechanical precision instruments and equipment.

Specialisations: Camera Repairer, Scalemaker, Scalemaker and Adjuster, Scientific Instrument Maker and Repairer, Weighing Scale Maker.

Related Titles: Instrument Fitter, Precision Instrument Maker.

1 Vehicle Painter

Prepares surfaces of vehicles, matches and mixes colours and applies paint.

Specialisations: Industrial Spray Painter.

2 Installer - Home Improvements

Installs useful and decorative home improvements such as awnings, curtains, blinds, flyscreens, garage doors, exterior cladding, shower screens and ready-made windows and doors.

Specialisations: Awnings Installer, Carport Erector, Curtain Fitter, Exterior Cladding Installer, Security Door Installer, Shower Screen Installer.

2 Plumber

Installs and repairs water, drainage, gas and sewerage pipes and systems.

Specialisations: Fire Services Plumber, Pipe Fitter (Plumbing), Pipe Joiner, Roof Plumber, Sanitary Plumber, Sprinkler Fitter, Water and Sewerage Reticulation Supervisor, Water Plumber.

2 Police Officer

Protects property and the public, and preserves safety through the enforcement of laws.

Specialisations: Aboriginal Liaison Officer, Anti Terrorist Specialist, Bomb Squad Officer, Commissioned Police Officer, Community Liaison Officer, Community Police Officer, Criminologist, Detective, Detective Sergeant, Diving/Water Police Officer, Emergency Services Co-ordinator, Federal Intelligence Agency Officer, Federal Police Officer, Government Investigation Agent, Home/Community Security Advisors, Mounted Police Officer, Police Assistant, Police Station Sergeant, Search and Rescue Officer, Tactical Response Group Officer, Traffic Police Officer.

2 Security System Installer

Assesses a client's security requirements, makes recommendations about how to improve security, and designs, installs and maintains locks, security devices and security monitoring and alarm equipment, and monitors alarm systems.

2 Truck Driver

Drives heavy trucks, which require a special licence to drive, to transport bulky goods and materials.

Specialisations: Concrete Mixer Driver, Haul Truck Driver, Livestock Haulier, Log Hauler, Log Truck Driver, Road Train Driver, Semi Trailer Driver, Stock Transport Driver, Tanker Driver, Tow Truck Driver.
